

Examinations Recognized by Izmir Bakircay University for International Student Applications for the 2026–2027 Academic Year

EXAM	STATEMENT
Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT)	Applicants must have obtained a minimum total score of 1000 out of 1600 on the SAT Reasoning Test (SAT1), calculated from the "Math" and "Evidence-Based Reading and Writing" sections (referred to as "Critical Reading" in the older version of the SAT). The SAT exam, which is administered as a university entrance examination, is recognized by our university for a period of 2 years. This 2-year period begins on the date the test results are announced and remains valid as long as the results are still within the validity period at the time of the university's application deadline. The tables outlining the criteria for the acceptance of SAT1 scores are provided below.
GCE AL Exam	The GCE A Level (AL) certificate will only be accepted from applicants who are solely citizens of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC), reside in the TRNC, and have completed their secondary education (high school) in the TRNC, provided that they meet the conditions specified in the relevant regulations of the Council of Higher Education (YÖK). There is no time limitation regarding the validity of the GCE A Level examination. The tables outlining the principles for the acceptance of GCE A Level exam scores are provided below.
Türkiye Exam for International Student Admission (TR-YÖS)	The TR-YÖS Exam is a centralized examination administered by ÖSYM (Assessment, Selection and Placement Center) across designated provinces in Turkey and in selected international representative countries. The exam is scored on a scale ranging from 100 to 500. The validity period of the TR-YÖS exam is two (2) years from the date of the examination. Applications will be considered valid only if the exam results are still within the validity period as of the university's application deadline. The tables outlining the criteria for the acceptance of TR-YÖS scores are provided below.

Faculty of Health Sciences	Language Therapy/ Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation/ Nursing / Audiology / Health Management	Applicants are required to have at least three “A” grades in the GCE AL (Advanced Level) exam, at least one of which should be from a subject related to the applied programme. The average of the accepted scores will be taken.
Faculty of Law	Law	Applicants are required to have at least three “A” grades in the GCE AL (Advanced Level) exam, at least one of which should be from a subject related to the applied programme. The average of the accepted scores will be taken.
Faculty of Medicine	Medicine	Applicants are required to have at least three “A” grades in the GCE AL (Advanced Level) exam, from the fields of Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics and Biology.
Menemen Vocational School	Laboratory and Veterinary Health	Applicants are required to have at least three “A” grades in the GCE AL (Advanced Level) exam, at least one of which should be from a subject related to the applied programme. The average of the accepted scores will be taken.
